

- » must be led by SMEs.
- » must be £50,000 to £150,000 in value.
- » can be 6 to 12 months in duration.
- » duration and cost must be commensurate.
- need to demonstrate evidence of proof-ofconcept.
- » Lead applicants must be registered in England.
